16 Isshiki Beach

A tranquil beach stretching out in front of the Imperial Villa in Hayama. Can be accessed by a day trip from Tokyo or Yokohama. In summer you can find beach houses and beach bars here and enjoy swimming. You can also enjoy a beautiful view of Mt. Fuji on clear days while relaxing in the tree shade and on the beach.

ACCESS: Approx. 20 mins bus ride bound for Hayama from JR Zushi Sta. Get off at Isshiki Kaigan stop and walk 3 mins.

18 Osanbashi Yokohama International Passenger Terminal

One of the largest-cruise terminals in Japan, where cruise ships and luxury ships from around the world stop. It's also a popular tourist spot. You can freely enter the wood deck-finished rooftop plaza 24 hours, and on clear days you can get excellent views of the Yokohama cityscape and Mt. Fuji.

ACCESS: Approx. 15 mins walk from JR Kannai Sta.

*As of March 2026, it may be difficult to see Mt. Fuji due to cranes and other devices being used due to building construction in the Minato Mirai area.

17 Kamakura Hasedera temple

The principle object of worship here is an Eleven-Faced Kannon Bodhisattva statue, standing at an impressive 9.18m - one of the largest wooden Buddhist statues in Japan. This ancient Kamakura temple features flowers and autumn leaves color the temple grounds all year. It also has a dining hall overlooking the sea and is a great place to take a stroll.

ACCESS: Approx. 6 min by bus bound for south exit of Fujisawa Sta. or for Kajiwara from JR Kamakura Sta., dose Hase Kannon stop.

19 YOKOHAMA AIR CABIN

This urban-style ropeway, connecting Unga Park in the Shinko area to just outside Sakuragichō Station, lets you enjoy a 5 min. air ride overlooking the Minato Mirai area in Yokohama. Taking a night ride surrounded by the glittering evening scenery is also recommended.

ACCESS: Approx. 1 min walk from JR Sakuragichō Sta.

Travel around Kanagawa by JR Lines!

Located right next to Tokyo, Yokohama is a truly international port town in Kanagawa Prefecture. From here, you can access incredible historical areas such as Kamakura and Odawara, and experience the beautiful coasts of Shonan, a popular tourist destination. Travel through Kanagawa on JR Lines and experience a new side to Japan!



1 Ryukanmi Murosada

A unique space where you can enjoy sweets and meals at the flowing river counter. The Cream Anmitsu, a traditional Japanese sweet with a perfect combination of fruits and red bean paste, is highly recommended.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 min by bus bound for Fudo daki Falls or Oku-Yugawara from JR Yugawara Sta., close to Ochialibashi stop.



2 Odawara Castle NINJA Museum (Observation Museum)

Odawara Castle is one of most famous castles in Kanagawa Prefecture. Enjoy the ninja experience at Odawara Castle Park, with its beautiful white castle tower! Have a fun time learning about history and the ninja using digital technology.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 mins walk from JR Odawara Sta.

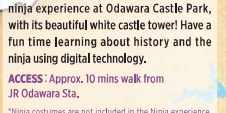

3 Azumayama Park

A scenic spot that gives you a view of the magnificent Mt. Fuji and Sagami Bay. Visitors can enjoy different flowers in every season - from January to February, around 60,000 early blooming Canola flowers color the mountain peaks in beautiful yellow, along with cherry blossoms in the spring, hydrangeas in the summer, and cosmos flowers in autumn.

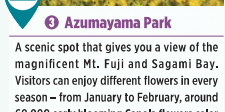
ACCESS: Approx. 5 mins walk from JR Ninomiya Sta., and approx. 20 mins walk from the Yokubaguchi route start to reach the summit.



4 Sagami Giant Kite Center

A facility dedicated to preserving and passing down the culture of Sagami Giant Kite Flying, a cultural event in Sagamihara, Kanagawa Prefecture that has gone on for around 190 years. The center lets you see a giant 146.41 sqm kite and enjoy a kite making experience.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 mins walk from JR Sobudaishita Sta.



5 Kumazawa Brewing Company

A unique brewery that was established in 1872 and is still around in the Shonan area. They provide the famous sake Tensei, with its refreshing tastes and delicious rice flavors, as well as Shonan Beer, a popular craft beer. The restaurant also serves food that goes well with Tensei and Shonan Beer.

ACCESS: Approx. 7 mins walk from JR Kagawa Sta.



9 Yokohama Zoological Gardens ZOORASIA

This zoo exhibits 570 animals of around 100 species, with a particular focus on rare animals throughout the world. You can observe many animals living comfortable lives in this spacious zoo! The interactive experience events are also popular, including their bird shows.

ACCESS: Approx. 18 min by bus bound for Yokohama Zoo from JR Nakayama Sta., and get off at the last stop.



6 Ofuna-Kannon-ji Temple

The pure white Kannon statue that can be seen from JR Ofuna Station is a White-Robed Kannon Bodhisattva, and visitors can even enter the inside! It stands at an impressive about 25m! Other recommendations include the "Flower Kannon", when the Kannon statue is surrounded by cherry blossoms, as well as attending seasonal events and obtaining goshuin seals.

ACCESS: Approx. 5 mins walk from JR Ofuna Sta.



7 Keihin Fushimi Inari Shrine

Built in 1951 by enshrining a deity's spirit from Fushimi Inari Shrine in Kyoto. It enshrines vermilion torii modeled after the Thousand Torii of Fushimi Inari Shrine, which is said to grant wishes, as well as 108 dynamic and expressive foto statues.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 mins walk from JR Musashi-Kosugi Sta.



11 Fujiko F. Fujio Museum, in Kawasaki City

This museum lets visitors experience the range of works and messages by Fujiko F. Fujio, the creators of Doraemon and other popular manga. Has exhibits featuring original pictures by the artist and photo spots with beloved characters.

*Reservation required for specific date and time
ACCESS: Approx. 9 min, by direct shuttle bus from JR Noborito Sta.



8 Shin-Yokohama Ramen Museum

The retro-style interior recreates an old-style Japanese cityscape and lets visitors eat and compare select ramen from all over Japan. The popular ramen making experience gives you a chance to make ramen with dough made from domestic wheat and lets you eat your creations right there in the museum.

ACCESS: Approx. 5 mins walk from JR Shin-Yokohama Sta.



10 Yokohama English Garden

A diverse amount of beautiful flowers bloom here, with a focus on around 2,200 varieties of roses. Experience the different seasons of Japan, from cherry blossoms in spring to hydrangeas and wind chime tunnels in early summer. Cafes and shops are also available.

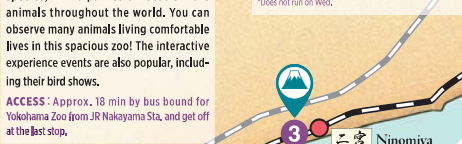
ACCESS: Approx. 10 min. by free shuttle bus from JR Yokohama Sta.
*Does not run on Wed.



11 Ichijo Ekan Sanso

This building, which was once a teahouse for the Imperial Family around 380 years ago, was relocated to Kamakura from Kyoto. It has been designated as an Important Cultural Property of Japan, as a valuable building that conveys the Imperial culture of the time. Drinking tea while gazing at the beautiful garden is a blissful experience.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 min by bus bound for Kamakura Reien Seimonnae Tachiarai or for Kanazawa-hakkei Sta., or the HIGH LAND LOOP bus from JR Kamakura Sta., Right outside Jomyoji stop.



9 Yokohama Zoological Gardens ZOORASIA

This zoo exhibits 570 animals of around 100 species, with a particular focus on rare animals throughout the world. You can observe many animals living comfortable lives in this spacious zoo! The interactive experience events are also popular, including their bird shows.

ACCESS: Approx. 18 min by bus bound for Yokohama Zoo from JR Nakayama Sta., and get off at the last stop.

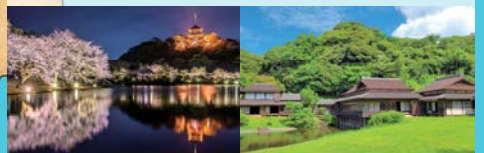

15 Sankeien Garden

A spacious Japanese garden consisting of around 175,000 square meters, built in 1906 by the businessman Sankei Hara. The garden interior features a skillful arrangement of historic buildings, including three storied pagodas and teahouses which collected from Kyoto and Kamakura. Here, visitors can relax and gaze at the atmospheric scenery and seasonal flowers.

ACCESS: Approx. 10 min by Route 58/101 City Bus from JR Negishi Sta., and approx. 10 mins walk from Honmoku stop.



14 Houseboat

This traditional Japanese sightseeing boat, with a roof and tatami seating, is said to trace its origins back over a thousand years to boat trips for the nobility. Eight companies operate houseboat cruises in Yokohama Port. Enjoy Japanese cuisine and sake while gazing at the Yokohama cityscape from the water's surface.

ACCESS: Approx. 3 mins walk from JR Sakuragicho Sta.
*Differs depending on boat



13 Noge Townscape

The Noge area features around 600 unique establishments including izakaya bars and jazz bars. Here, you can enjoy a nostalgic atmosphere that can only be experienced in Japan, such as the Noge Miyakobashi Shotengai Building.

ACCESS: Approx. 1 min walk from JR Sakuragicho Sta.
*The Noge Miyakobashi Shotengai Bldg is approx. 5 min from JR Sakuragicho Sta.
